- 4th Conjugation DIV-ĀDI-GAŅA: Add "Y" before endings; no *Guṇa*
- 6th Conjugation TUD-ĀDI-GAŅA: Add endings directly to root; no *Guṇa*
- 10th Conjugation ĆUR-ĀDI-GAŅA: Add "AY" before endings; *Guṇa* of short penultimate vowel / V*ṛddhi* of final vowel.
