

garja garja - from Devi-māhātmyam

गर्ज गर्ज क्षणम् मुढ मधु यावत्पिबाम्यहम् ।
मया त्वयि हतेऽत्रैव गर्जियन्त्याशु देवताः ॥३८॥

38. garja garja kṣaṇam muḍha madhu yāvatpibāmyaham
mayā tvayi hate'traiva garjiṣyantyāśu devatāḥ

The Devi said: 'Roar, roar, O fool, for a moment while I drink this wine. When you will be slain by me, the devas will soon roar in this very place.'

garja garja – roar, roar (imperative 2nd person singular: you (must) roar)

kṣaṇam – a moment

muḍha – oh fool

madhu – this sweetness, wine

yāvat - (yāvat – while, as long as)

pibāmi – I drink

aham - I

mayā – by me (first person pronoun, instrumental singular)

tvayi - in this (very place), here

hate – be slain

atra – here

eva – just, only

garjiṣyanti - they all will roar (futuretense 3rd person plural)

āśuḥ soon, quickly

devatāḥ – all the Goddesses
